Make friends at our Playgroup

St Brigid's School offers playgroup for all children from birth to 5 years of age. Playgroup is a fun way to meet other parents in our school and community.

At playgroup, you and your child will have the opportunity to make friends, discover new skills and build connections by spending time with parents, family members and caregivers. Activities may include singing, playing, and listening to stories or music.

All of our playgroup activities are developed by a qualified educator.

Each activity is created as an opportunity for children to build play-based skills including problem-solving, cooperation and sharing.

**St Brigid's School
Transition Program**

We offer a year-long transition program for enrolled Reception students to help them prepare for school.

This is a wonderful opportunity for children to settle into the routine of learning before they are at school full-time.

This program starts 12 months prior to the child's first year of Reception, giving them more time to adjust to school.

Each session is run by a qualified trained educator who creates a structured program of learning to build your child's foundational skills, setting your child up for life.

Submit your Enrolment Application

To enrol your child at our school, please fill out your details in an Enrolment Application form and submit the completed form and any supporting documents to our office staff or email info@stb.catholic.edu.au.



Attend an enrolment interview

Once you have submitted your application, our office staff will organise a time for you to talk with the principal. This time is spent talking with you about your child's experiences and learning styles.



Respond to an Offer of Placement

We will contact you if you receive an Offer of Placement and send you an Acceptance of Offer form. You must return the signed form to the school to accept the offer.



Your child's first days at St Brigid's

Before starting school, we arrange a visit to your child's kindergarten or pre-school by a staff member. This builds your child's connection with our school community and makes sure your child has a smooth transition when they start school.

When your child starts school, we have Induction and Welcome meetings for all new parents. During this time, you get to know the staff that support your child's learning and meet other parents who are also joining our school.

We also provide a welcome pack with extra information about starting at our school to make sure your child's transition to school is comfortable and easy.
